SUPERVISION RATES: The minimum Foreman/General Foreman rates are as follows: **FOREMAN** - \$3.50 additional per hour – **GENERAL FOREMAN** - \$5.00 – minimum rates.

PARKING PREMIUM – the employer may choose to pay \$2.75 per hour worked to employees that provide their own transportation.

Fringe Benefits are paid only on actual hours worked with the exceptions of the ****Defined Benefit Pension** and ****Defined Contribution Pension**, which will be paid at the applicable overtime.

The Elected 401(k) is deducted and deposited at the straight time rate.
